INTERNATIONAL SUMMER COURSE ON LEGAL ASPECTS OF EUROPEAN INTEGRATION 19-31 August, 1968

The « Europa Instituut » of the University of Amsterdam, in co-operation with the Netherlands Universities Foundation for International Co-operation (NUFFIC), will organize an International Summer Course on Legal Aspects of European Integration at Amsterdam, to be held from 19-31 August 1968.

The course is open to graduates in law and the language of instruction will be English.

The programme, consisting of lectures and discussion meetings, will be held immediately after the 1968 summer session of the Hague Academy of International Law.

The lecturers in the course are recruited from university professors and other experts in the field of European integration.

The course will probably be concluded by an excursion to Brussels, the headquarters of the European Economic Community.

During the course the participants will be accommodated in the student hostel « Anne Frankhuis » which is situated in the centre of Amsterdam.

INTERNATIONAL COURSE ON EUROPEAN INTEGRATION Amsterdam : September 1968 - May 1969

Herewith I should like to ask your attention for the third International (post-graduate) Course on European Integration which will be held at the « Europa Instituut » of the University of Amsterdam from September 12, 1968 till May 13, 1969.

The course which will be held in the English language is organized by the « Europa Instituut » in co-operation with the Netherlands Universities Foundation for International Co-operation (NUFFIC) and is primarily destined for nationals from member states of the European Economic Community (EEC), the Economic Free Trade Association (EFTA) and North America, though candidates from other countries who take a special interest in the problems of European integration are also welcome to attend.

The lecturers in the course are both professors coming from various Dutch Universities and experts who have gained experience in the field of integration through their professional connections with the European Communities, Benelux, and OECD.

During the first term introductory tutorials and lectures on general problems of integration will be held followed during the second term by lectures, seminars and conferences on specific problems, individual research and a study tour to the European Institutions.

Twice a month informal discussion evenings will be organized where Dutch and foreign experts on different aspects of European integration will discuss current problems.

The tuition fee is 1000 Dutch guilders (abt. £ 100.0.0).

There is a limited number of fellowships available.
